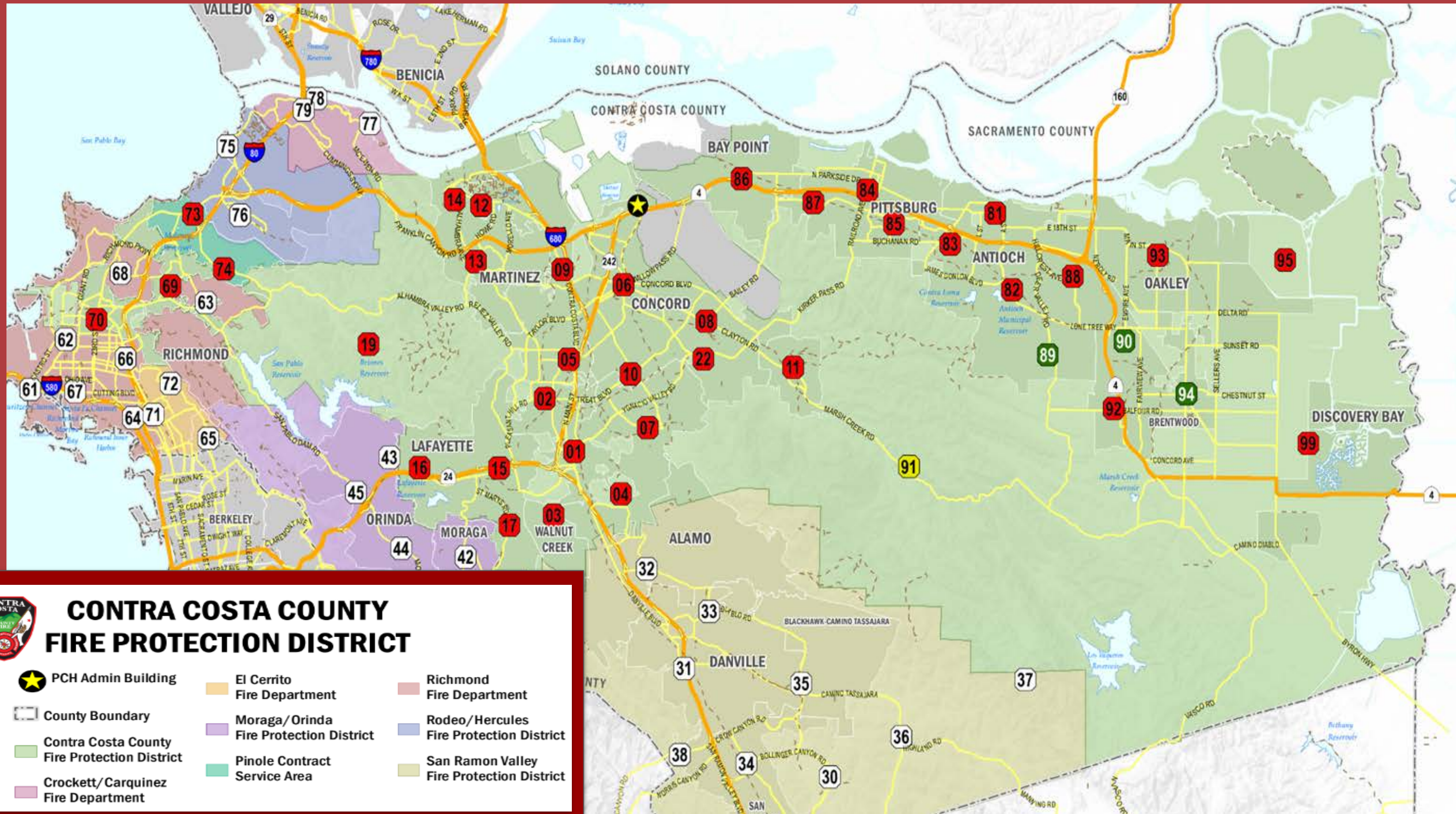

- All-hazards, full-service fire district

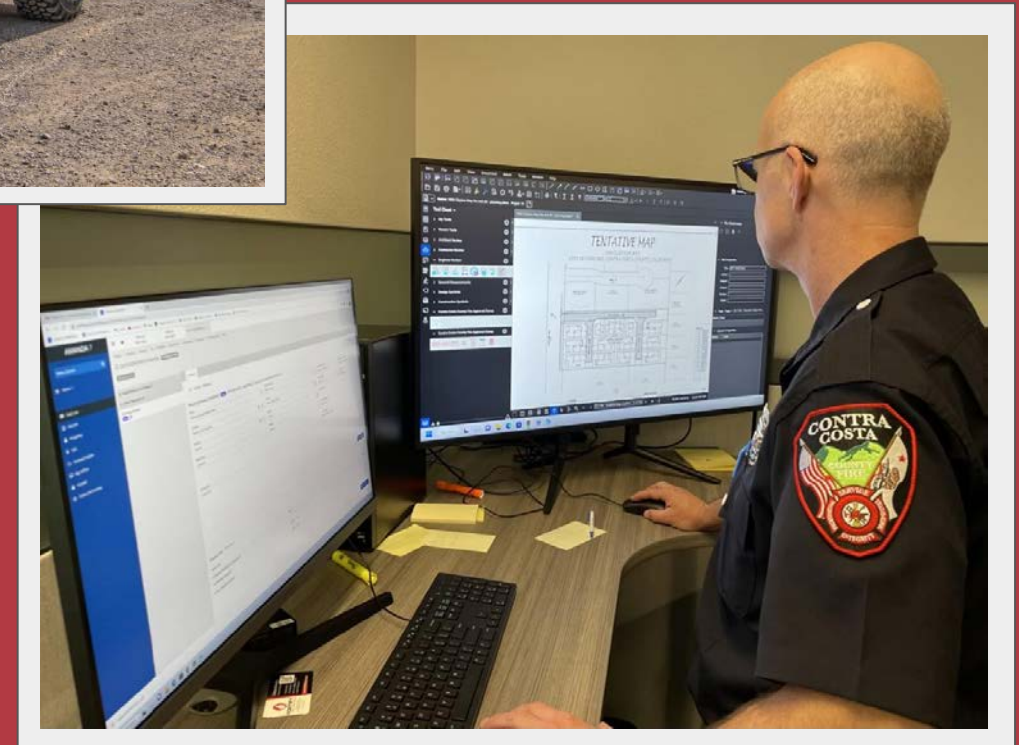

- Skeeter wildland apparatus has been ordered

2023 Contra Costa Fire Accomplishments

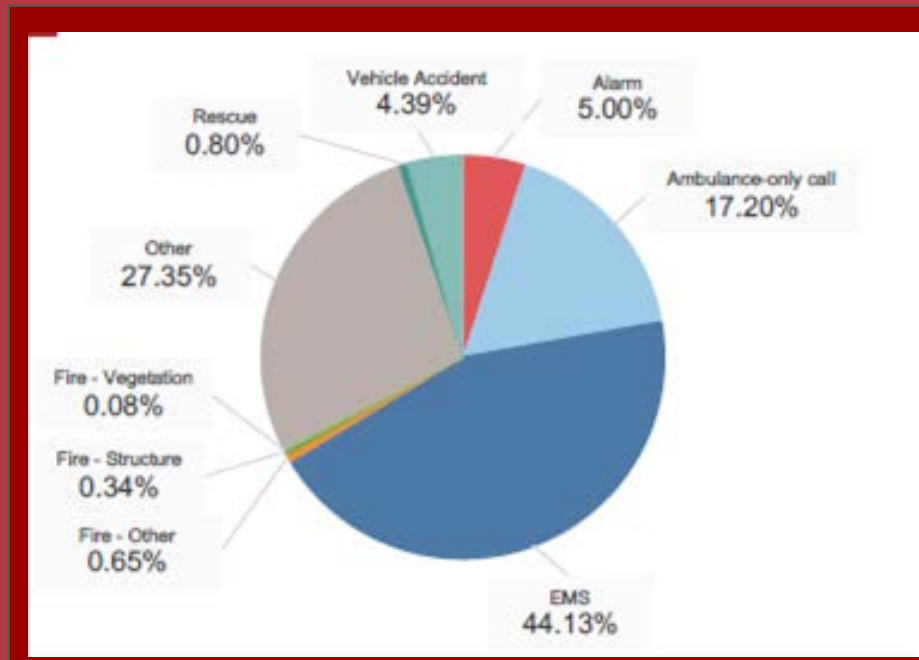
- 18 months since the East Contra Costa annexation
- Construction plans began for three new fire stations
- New companies for Station 74, 86, 81, and 92
- Hand crew was fully staffed for the entire calendar year
- Tiered ambulance response model
- Fully staffed operations
- Fire Chaplain

2023 City of Pinole Response Numbers



2,622 Total Calls for Service

- Average of 219 calls per month
- Over 61% of calls were EMS related
- Significant events
 - 7/4/2023: Multi-family residential structure fire on Estates ave
 - 7/17/2023: Residential structure fire on Doidge Ave
 - 7/31/2023: Residential structure fire on McDonald Drive
 - 8/23/2023: Approximately two acre vegetation fire
 - 2/20/2024: Residential structure fire on Calais Drive

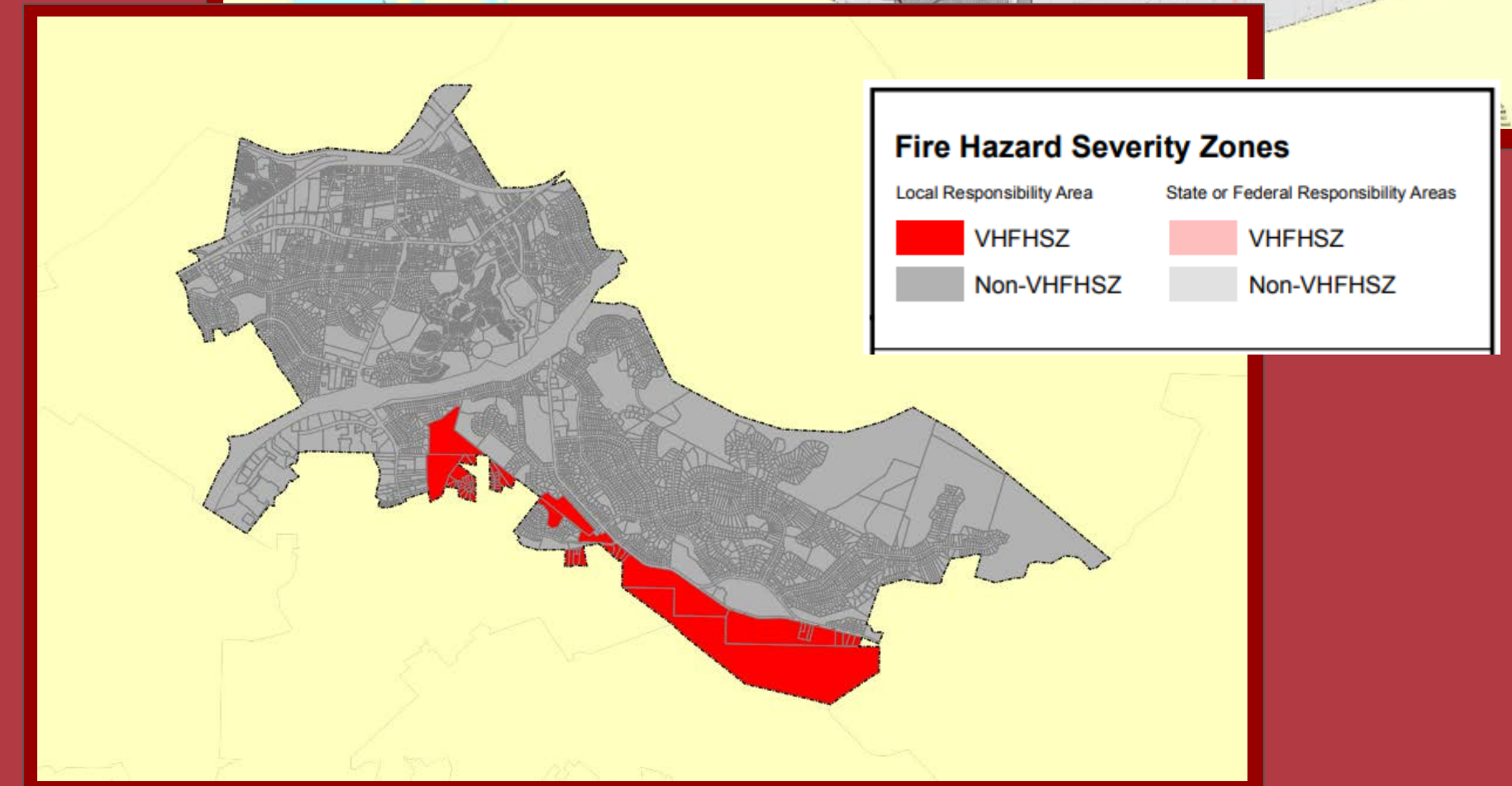
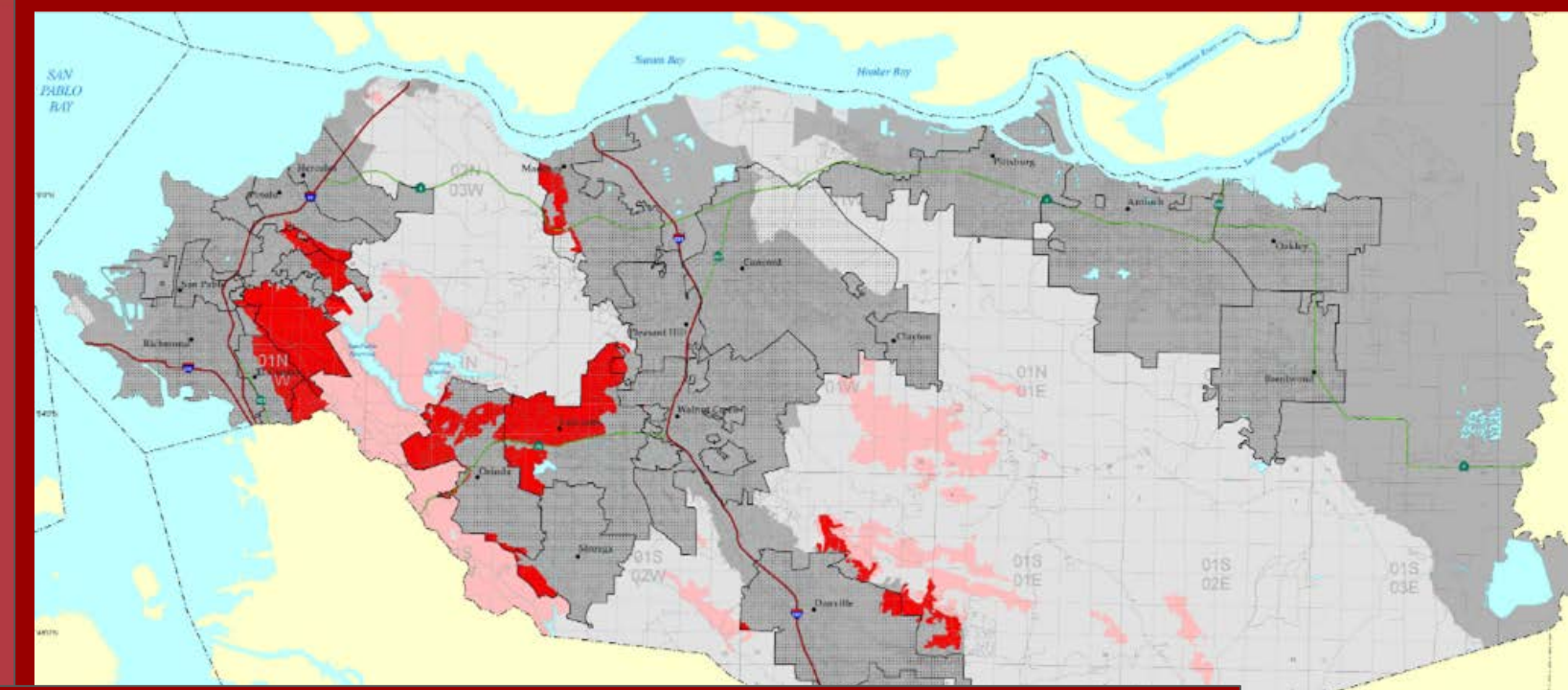

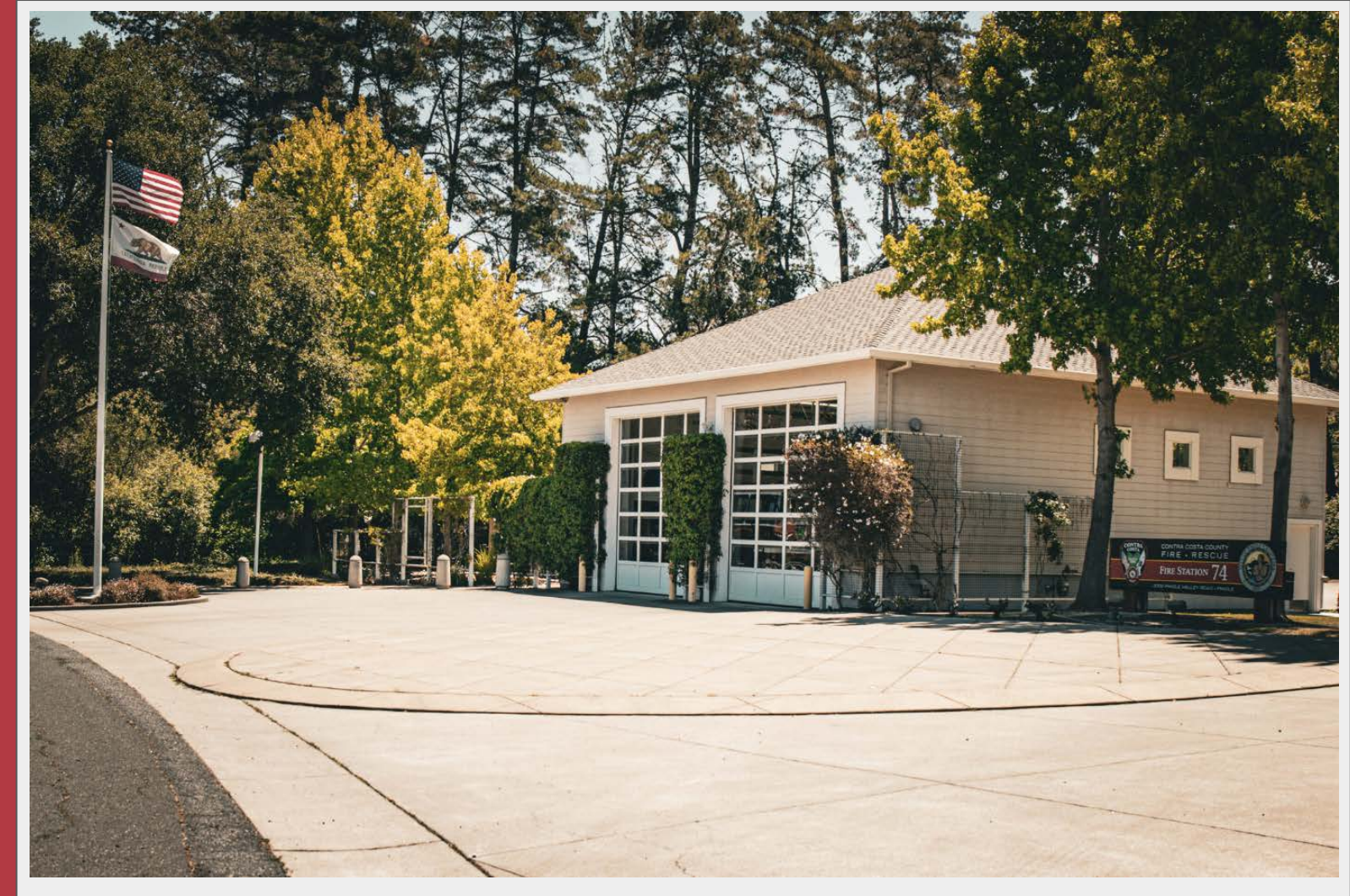
