# NAMING THE BASKETBALL COURT AT FERNANDEZ PARK AFTER DAVID PATRICK UNDERWOOD

At its meeting on July 21, 2020, the City Council approved naming the basketball court at Fernandez Park after David Patrick Underwood. Mr. Underwood was a well-respected Pinole resident and community member who was tragically killed in May 2020 while providing security for the federal court building in Oakland. He spent much of his childhood at the basketball court in Fernandez Park. City staff will work with community partners to repave and repaint the basketball court in Mr. Underwood's memory.

#### POTENTIAL NOVEMBER 2020 SPECIAL PARCEL TAX FOR FIRE SERVICE

Due to the current COVID situation and the inability to have in-person City Council meeting, the City Council, at its meeting on July 21, 2020, directed City staff not to take steps to place a special parcel tax measure to fund additional fire service on the November 2020 ballot. The Council believed that an in-person meeting format would allow for much more full and robust public participation and dialog on the final report's findings and recommendations. Related, the City's fire service study consultants, Emergency Services Consulting International (ESCI), is tentatively scheduled to present its final report on the City's fire service model at the City Council meeting of September 1, 2020. Note that this date might change.

#### 2020 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

The next General Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 and will include the election of two Pinole City Council seats and Pinole City Treasurer. The nomination period for candidates opens on July 13, 2020 and closes on August 7, 2020. This is the period when individuals officially receive, circulate, and file nomination papers for candidacy.

#### **CENSUS 2020! IT'S TIME TO RESPOND!**

There's no denying we are living in unnerving and uncertain times as we respond to the COVID-19 pandemic. That's why it's more important than ever that everyone respond to Census 2020. In fact, how we respond to this Census will impact our ability to respond to future public health crises like the one we are living through right now. Thankfully, the Census is a social distancing approved activity and it has never been easier to respond in the comfort and safety of your own home.

By now, all households should have received a notification in the mail inviting them to respond to the census. You can fill out the census online at <a href="my2020census.gov">my2020census.gov</a>, by phone (<a href="numbers available in 13 languages at this link">numbers available in 13 languages at this link</a>), or by mail. Starting Mid-May, the Census Bureau will begin sending out Enumerators to follow up with households who haven't responded.

Make sure to count **everyone** living in your household as of April 1, 2020. Remember, your responses are confidential and will shape how much federal funding and civic representation our Pinole gets **for the next decade**. When you've completed your census post a picture on your social media with your receipt and tag #CountMeIn and #CoCoCounts.
