CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE

Contra Costa County entered the **purple** tier of California's Blueprint for a Safer Economy on November 17, 2020, due to the adjusted average daily number of new COVID-19 cases in Contra Costa doubling in recent weeks, rising from 4.3 per 100,000 population on October 16 to 9.2 on November 16. Effective November 21st, non-essential activities should cease between 10:00 pm and 5:00 am in counties in the Widespread (**purple**) tier.

Changes caused by the State's action will include:

- Social gatherings involving people from different households are permitted outdoors only, with a maximum of three households and 25 people, preferably for less than two hours.
- K-12 schools may not reopen for in-person instruction unless they have already begun to do so.
- Worship services and cultural ceremonies must now be held outdoors only.
- Higher education institutions must move indoor lectures and student gatherings outdoors only.
- Movie theaters may operate outdoors only.
- Museums and exhibit spaces may open outdoors only.

In response to the latest Health Orders, City Hall is open on an appointment-only basis for the time being. Certain City facilities will remain closed for the time being, including the Senior Center and Youth Center. The City will reopen these facilities as soon as possible.

NOTICE TO MERCHANTS – BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL TIME

Attention Business Owners – 2020 Pinole Business Licenses will expire on December 31, 2020. Business license taxes for 2021 are due on January 1, 2021 and become delinquent on February 1, 2021, at which time unpaid taxes are subject to a 50% penalty. There is no change to the business license tax rate for calendar year 2021. The tax for the basic business license is \$145 per year (not including the \$4 AB 1379 State-mandated fee).

Business license renewal forms are being mailed out November 25, 2020 for calendar year 2021. Renewal forms are mailed to you as a courtesy; we make every effort to make sure that a renewal form is mailed to each active business. If you do not receive a renewal form, it is the business owner's responsibility to pay the business license tax by January 31, 2021. If you are no longer conducting business, please check the Inactive box in the upper right-hand corner of the courtesy renewal form, sign it, and return it to us.

Deck the Halls Contest



Free Virtual Holiday Youth Baking Class


