CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE

On 12/2/2020, the State has issued a new Regional Stay at Home Order. The Order modifies the State's COVD-19 response strategy in three significant ways:

- It groups counties into one of five regions (Contra Costa is part of the 11-county Bay Area region).
- Restrictions will be triggered by a new metric, regional ICU capacity; and
- The Order slightly modifies which activities will be restricted for different tiers relative to what had been required previously under the California Blueprint for a safer economy.

On 12/4/2020, Contra Costa County, along with other Bay Area counties, decided to implement the strictest restrictions of the State's new Regional Stay at Home Order, effective 12/6/2020 through 1/4/2021.

In response to the latest Health Orders, City Hall is open on an appointment-only basis for the time being. Certain City facilities will remain closed for the time being, including the Senior Center and Youth Center. The City will reopen these facilities as soon as possible.

Parks Update

Updated State guidance allows outdoor playgrounds and outdoor fitness equipment to reopen with social distancing and face coverings. Follow these simple tips to make your visit safe and fun. Free Virtual Holiday Youth Baking Class




