

WEED ABATEMENT UPDATE

We are well into the 2020 fire season, as illustrated by several fire incidents in and around Pinole. The Pinole Fire Department will be conducting additional weed abatement efforts throughout the City's open space in the weeks to come.





By now, all residents' weeds should be removed to within three inches off the ground and brush trimmed to provide a safety buffer of at least thirty feet around any structure. For most properties within the City, this means clearing the entire parcel. Dead trees and

fallen limbs also apply. Tree limbs must be trimmed to no lower than six feet from the ground. Thank you for your efforts in making Pinole a fire safe community!

2020 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

The next General Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 and will include the election of two Pinole City Council seats and Pinole City Treasurer. The nomination period for candidates opens on July 13, 2020 and closes on August 7, 2020. This is the period when individuals officially receive, circulate, and file nomination papers for candidacy.

CENSUS 2020! IT'S TIME TO RESPOND!

There's no denying we are living in unnerving and uncertain times as we respond to the COVID-19 pandemic. That's why it's more important than ever that everyone respond to Census 2020. In fact, how we respond to this Census will impact our ability to respond to future public health crises like the one we are living through right now. Thankfully, the Census is a social distancing approved activity and it has never been easier to respond in the comfort and safety of your own home.

By now, all households should have received a notification in the mail inviting them to respond to the census. You can fill out the census online at my2020census.gov, by phone (numbers available in 13 languages at this link), or by mail. Starting Mid-May, the Census Bureau will begin sending out Enumerators to follow up with households who haven't responded.

Make sure to count **everyone** living in your household as of April 1, 2020. Remember, your responses are confidential and will shape how much federal funding and civic representation our Pinole gets **for the next decade**. When you've completed your census post a picture on your social media with your receipt and tag #CountMeIn and #CoCoCounts.
