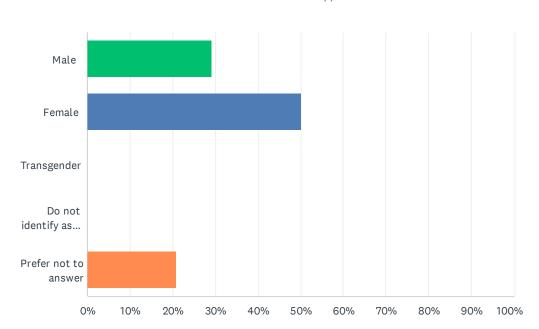

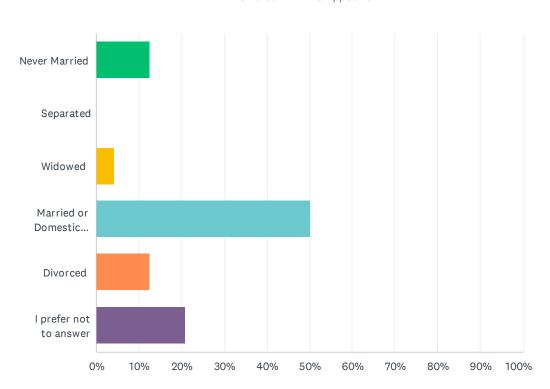

Q7 What is your marital status?

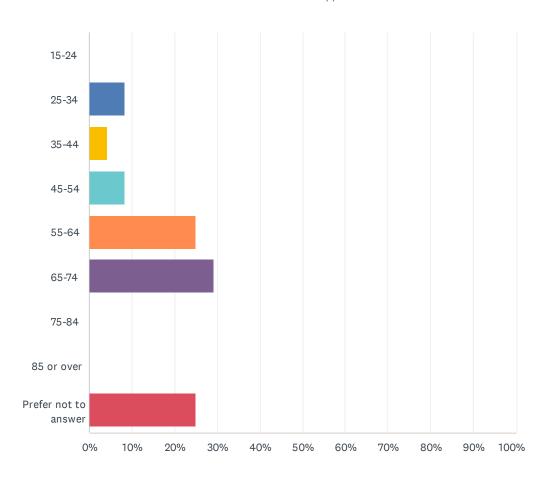

Q8 What is your age?

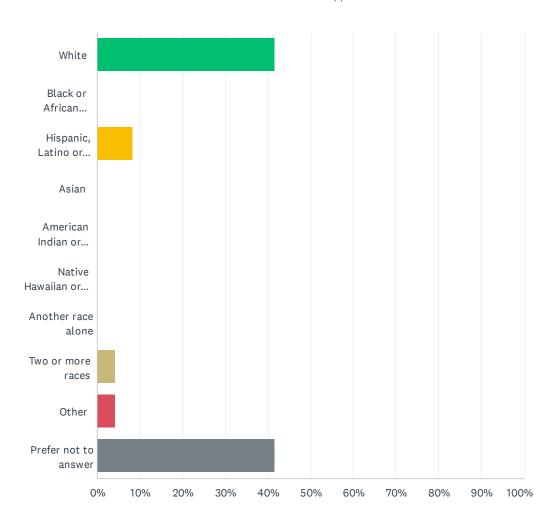

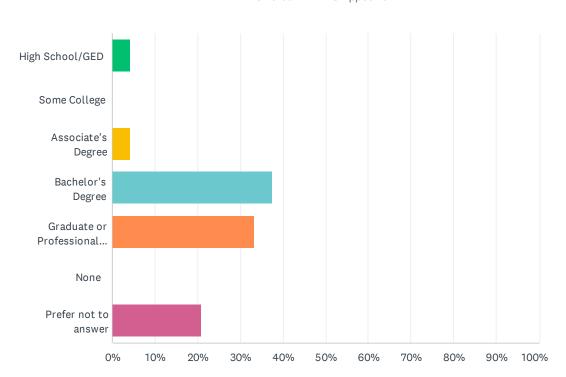

Q10 What is your highest formal education level?

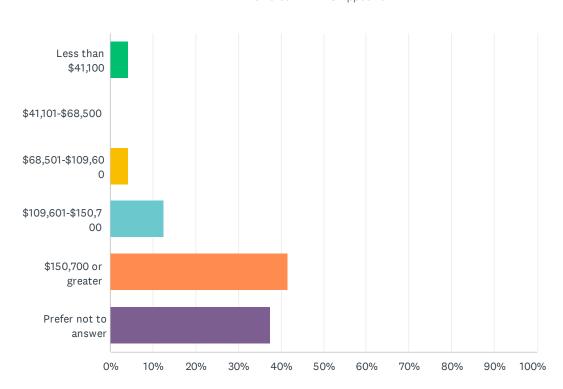

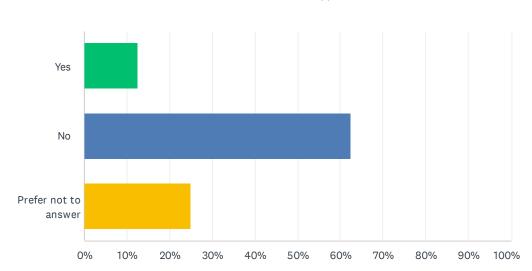

Q12 Do you have a disability?

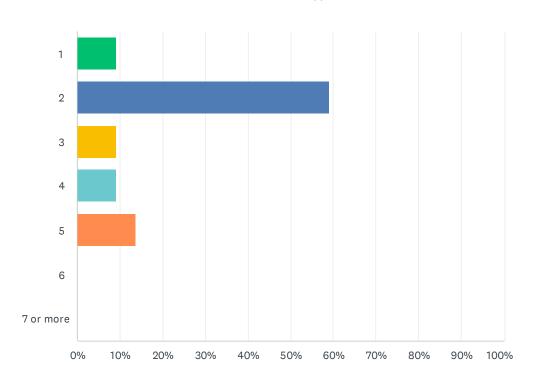

Q13 How many people do you have in your household, including yourself?

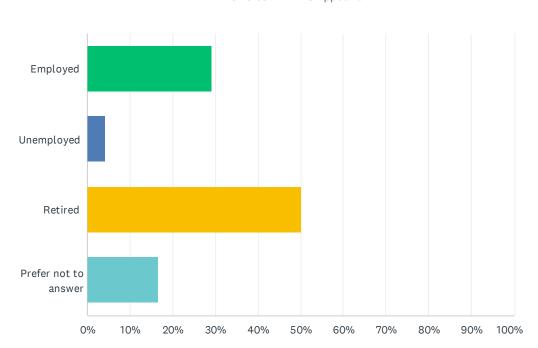

Q14 What is your employment status?

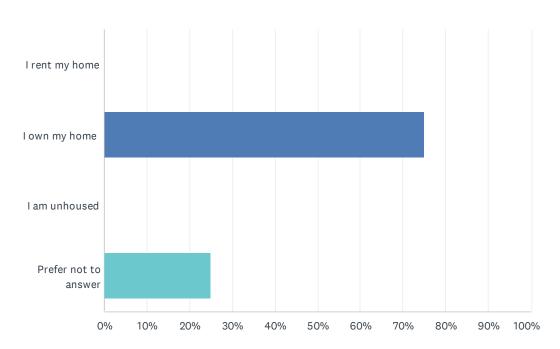

Q15 What is your housing situation?

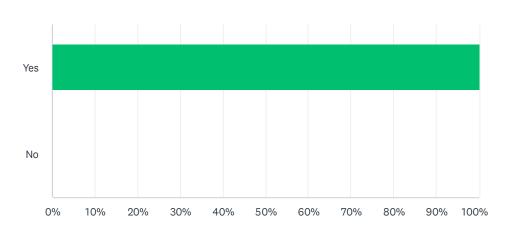

Q16 Are you a resident of Pinole?

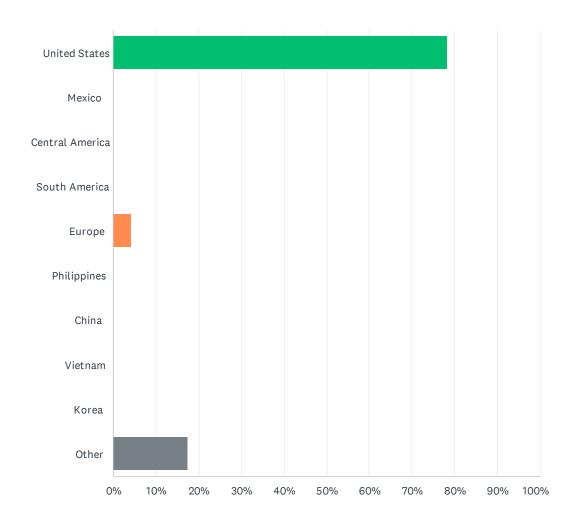
